NOTE TO ALL PLAYERS

CUPS & TROPHIES may be retained by their winners until the start of next tournament when they should be returned, having been appropriately engraved at the winner's own expense beforehand, to the Manager or SACA Secretary. Trophies **may not** be taken out of South Africa but overseas-based winners will have engraving done on their behalf by SACA

GENERAL CONDITIONS AND INFORMATION

The LAWS OF ASSOCIATION CROQUET Sixth Edition (amended 2008), WCF GOLF CROQUET RULES 2007 and SACA REGULATIONS FOR TOURNAMENTS June 2007 shall apply, including any amendments circulated by SACA prior to the tournament.

1. Entries on the official entry form accompanied by the entrance fees must reach the SACA Secretary not later than **10th October, 2010. Entrants are advised to PLEASE check with Secretary timeously that their entry forms were received.**
2. Printed draw sheets will be issued to each player on the first day of the tournament.
3. Unless otherwise advised, Association Croquet competitors are to report to the Country Club Johannesburg by 07.45 on 15th November, 2010; and Golf Croquet competitors to the same venue by 07:45 on 22nd November, 2010.
4. It is each player's responsibility to find out when and where he/she is due to play each day and to ascertain the details of each match. (i.e. whether it is time limited, handicap, level, double banked, etc). The Manager will supply this information on request but it is the responsibility of players to ensure that they have all necessary information and data relevant to their matches.
5. Competitors are advised to read 'SACA Regulations for Tournaments June 2007'. Special attention is drawn to the following:
 - (a) The tournament programme may be altered at the discretion of the Manager or in agreement with the Tournament Committee. (Regulation M2.c).
 - (b) Leave of absence will be granted only in exceptional circumstances, and only with the Manager's permission. If leave of absence has not been granted and players are absent or otherwise unable to play when called upon to do so by the Manager they are liable to be disqualified. Competitors are requested to note on their entry form whether any leave of absence may be required. (Regulation M2.b)
 - (c) The Manager is authorised to impose a time limit on an entire event, or any round in an event and on any game. (Regulations M2.c / T1 and T5).
 - (d) The Manager is empowered to introduce the Two-Life variation on any event that is not a first-class event. (Regulation M2.c.7).

- (e) Ties for winning/progressive positions in a block will be resolved according to the current Regulations F2.b and F2.c.
- 6. A telephone contact number is essential during the tournament. Home, business or mobile telephone numbers should be supplied in case a problem arises at the draw or subsequently.
- 7. Play will continue while there is sufficient light. This decision will be made by the Manager.
- 8. As soon as possible after the end of each match players are to report the score and to check whether they are required for further play. Even if not scheduled to play players must still check with the Manager before leaving the venue.
- 9. Competitors may practice on the courts during the hours of play after first obtaining permission from the Manager and under such conditions as imposed. (Reg. P4.e).

ADDITIONAL NOTES ON TOURNAMENT

1. An inter-provincial golf croquet match will be played on Sunday, 21 November commencing at 14h00.
2. We would like to record our thanks to Warwick Wealth who are sponsoring the tournament.
3. Various inexpensive lunches are available at the club. These range from toasted sandwiches to pub food etc. Morning and afternoon teas/coffee are covered by the entry fee.
4. Several casual suppers or braais will be arranged during the tournament as well as the prize-giving cocktail party on Saturday, 27 November. More details will follow.
5. The SACA AGM will be held during the tournament, probably on Thursday, 25 November. The formal notice and agenda will be sent out nearer the time.

6. Accommodation

CCJ has a facility in the grounds at Auckland Park called ‘The Lodge’ which has \pm 18 rooms with en-suite bathrooms. The cost is \pm R700 per room per night excluding breakfast. Obviously the advantage is that you can walk through the gardens to the croquet lawns. Contact Chris & Christine Wakeham if you wish to book a room. There are also several B & B’s in the Auckland Park/Melville area.

If the cost of accommodation discourages some players who do not have family or friends they can stay with, please contact Chris & Christine Wakeham because some of the Gauteng croquet players have offered to accommodate visiting players in their homes.
